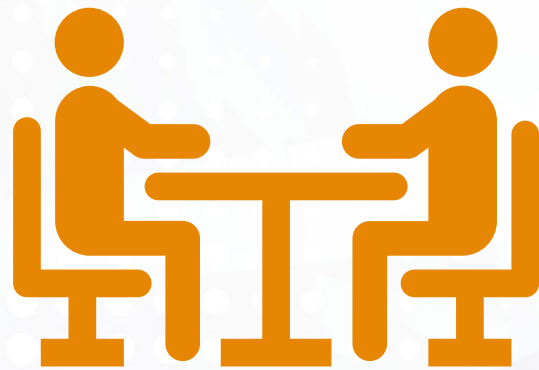



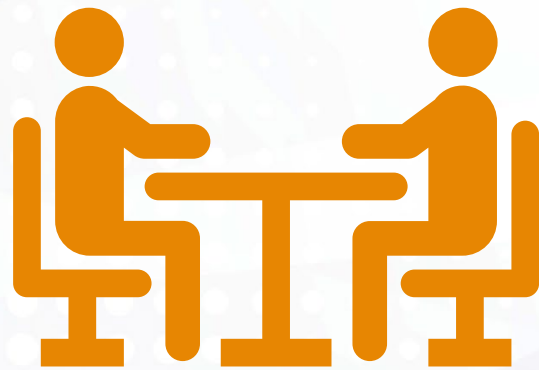

The bridge program may also serve to support student **transition from middle school to the P-TECH** program.

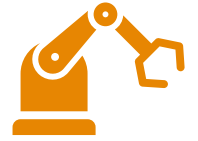

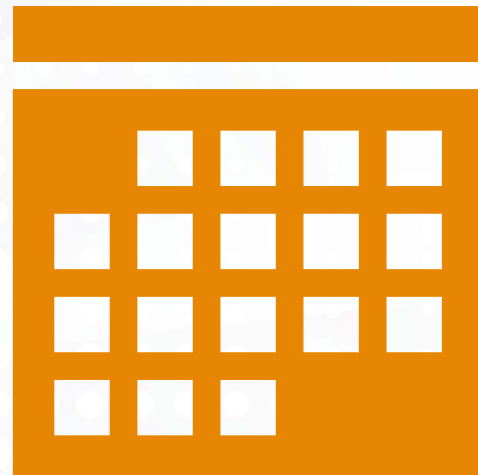
