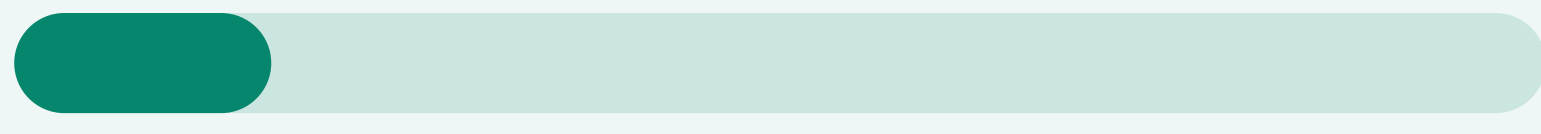

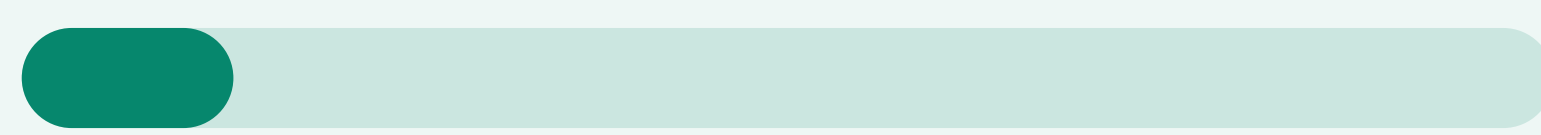

### WHAT IS P-TECH?

Pathways in Technology Early College High Schools (P-TECH) are innovative open-enrollment high schools that allow students least likely to attend college an opportunity to receive both a high school diploma and a credential.

Clarksville ISD has partnered with Paris Junior College, Paris Regional Health, and Stacer Group to offer students an opportunity to enroll in the Clarksville ISD P-TECH program focused on nursing science in the health care industry.

### THE CLARKSVILLE ISD P-TECH PROGRAM:

- Enables students to earn a high school diploma along with a Level I certificate from Paris Junior College.
- Offers work-based learning opportunities in partnership with Stacer Group and local businesses.
- Allows students to gain work experience through internships and other job training programs in partnership with Paris Regional Health.
